SSSF Minutes Board meeting August 4, 2011

Commodore's Report: The first order of business was to decide if the board would continue to meet one hour before the regular meeting. It was agreed by all that this would continue. Charles has been asked if he would continue as commodore, he stated he would do so if the majority of the board would continue as well. All but two were willing to continue to serve on the board for 2012. Email issues continue. Charles will contact Cynthia to see what is happening.

Sailing director's report: Mary Ann reported there were 14 sails reported in July. The next club activity is the international wine and cheese raft up on Aug 13th. She has received complaints that some people are not getting on boats. The Boatathalon will be Sept 17th.

Social Director: Marie reports that 55 holiday party tickets have been sold. She and Charles discussed having a End of the summer Clam Bake as the next party. Costs of clams will be investigated to see if this is affordable.

An Article from the local newspaper

Boaters will have to slow down in more sections of Broward County, under the first changes to the county's manatee-protection zones in 18 years.

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission on Wednesday approved the first update since 1993, taking into account better knowledge of manatees' movements and the increase in boats. Boats and other watercraft have killed 64 manatees in Florida so far this year, including two in Broward, according to the commission.

The changes would affect several waterways, with the greatest impact coming on the Intracoastal, where some weekend slow-speed zones would go to seven days a week from Nov. 15 to March 31. During the winter migration season, hundreds of manatees travel the Intracoastal, shuttling between the warm-water discharge zones of the county's two power plants and food sources to the north.

The changes would add about 18 minutes to the trip down the Intracoastal from county line to county line during the winter migration season. But the commission, a sevenmember board appointed by the governor, rejected a proposal from its staff for a more restrictive speed zone from Sunrise Boulevard to Las Olas Boulevard. Broward is among the most important counties in the state for the endangered marine mammals, with as many as 927 manatees counted in the county in a single day. Watercrafts have killed an average of slightly more than three a year in Broward since 2005.
