Minutes Board meeting, April 5, 2012 Present: Charles, Debra, Debbie, Jane, Nancy, Dot, Rich, Marie. Absent: Max, Mary Ann

The meeting was called to order by Charles at 6:55 PM

Commodore's Report: Charles suggested we locate another venue for the board and general meetings as it has been difficult to hold meetings at Mc Guires. Charles questioned the amount of money the 50/50 is bringing in. Marie stated that when it has been done every week, fewer people participate. The amounts are correct.

There are 30 people on the crew list who have not yet been out on a sail, however 15 of them have been invited and turned down the opportunity to sail. She plans to discuss crew signing up for, then not showing up for sails at the general meeting. The next planned sail/raft-up/party will be May 5<sup>th</sup> with a Derby Day theme (hats, mint juleps, bets) More to come.

Social Director's Report: Nancy stated that the April 1st party was well attended. The next club event will be the after boat clean up party at Debbie's on the 14th. Then will be the Air and Sea Show on the 28th. She and Debbi are working on the Derby Day party. She met with the banquet manager of the hotel on Powerline and Commercial and they are willing to have the club meet there to see if it will work to change the general and board meetings to that venue. She has also booked Gallupi's for the holiday party. She reported that Gulfstream Sailing Club has extended invitations to SSSF for some of their social events. This will be mentioned at the general meeting.

Marketing director's report: Deborah stated that she would like help from someone in the club with more internet experience and savvy. Charles suggested she form a committee.
