New Year

The **Change of Command** went off very well thank you to everyone for your help and the SSSF members attendance, in what as a wonderful evening.

Congratulations to **Captain of the Year Mike Efford** and **Member of the Year Debi Hallmark -** well deserved. The **Nautical Flea Market** was a great opportunity to build awareness and sell nautical products from members. The **January sail** got members on the water! February looks like another month filled with events!

General Meeting

I spoke about the Reserve Account and started out reminding members of our Board's mission, as follows:

<u>Board Duties</u>: The Board acts as the governing body of the Club, is responsible to the Members for conformance with the By-Laws, and carries out their specific duties as assigned elsewhere in these By-Laws.

<u>Commodore:</u> The Commodore is the Chief Executive Officer of the Club, oversees and directs its affairs, ...

The Reserve Account was brought to my attention several times when I was running for office and at a General meeting and they asked me: "What about the Reserve Account?"

So, for a month, I researched and read three years of board meeting minutes, reviewed general meeting minutes and spoke with past board members.

The questions were: what was done, how was it done, and when was it done:

- <u>First</u> The Board set up the Reserve Account to protect the club, from what originally was an IRS issue that could have arisen.
- 2. <u>Second</u> The members ran fundraisers to protect the club, which generated \$10,000, and this was set aside in a Reserve Account in 2014.

- 3. <u>Third</u> The IRS issue was resolved and then members asked the Board what were they going to do with the Reserve Account money.
- 4. <u>Fourth</u> Members were asked for their suggestions which were compiled by the Board. Some not so feasible, but most were serious. Then the committee compiled the feedback and presented it to the Board for approval.
- 5. <u>Finally</u> The Board responded by utilizing the funds and this is **how and when it was done**:

Liability Insurance	\$1,100.00
IRS Cost	\$850.00
Reduces 1 year membership*	\$1,800.00
Total	\$9,345.00

*One-time renewal discount of \$65.00 for 90 members or Member \$20.00 savings

The Board as "the governing body of the Club to the Members" completed its responsibility. Thereby having properly, and in a timely manner, completed its "responsibilities to its members."

The Board in **2017 decided** to best protect the club and continue with the Reserve Account for the future.

I think the best we as Board members, and myself as Commodore can do, is respond to and inform our members. I hope to continue to be helpful and informative in the coming year.
