

General Meeting Minutes

January 3, 2019

Call to order: Commodore Ethel Facundo opened meeting at 7:00 pm. She welcomed everyone and recognized/thanked the efforts of the 2018 board members. She also thanked everyone for electing her as Commodore 2019.

She went on to address all present, and remind everyone of:

- Membership renewal
- COC.

Vice Commodore: Bill Bratt - Stated that his function as Vice Commodore entails executing two SOS events throughout the calendar year. He states that he is working on setting the dates for them and will be looking for volunteers.

Treasurer: Colleen Murphy - She is currently working to finalize the 2019 budget. She states that at the end of 2018, the club's operating account balance is approximately \$14,000. It was also pointed out at that time that this amount did not include \$10,000 in a reserve account.

Secretary Report: Daniele Haddad - Motion to waive the reading of the minutes of the December 2018 meeting was made by Debi Hallmark, 2nd by Lynette Beal. Motion carried.

Sailing Director: Rich Luce - He will be working closely this year with Fleet Captain, Debi Hallmark to insure a successful sailing year. Currently, he is planning a Saturday Day Sail for every month of the year, and will be reaching out to the captains for their participation. Dates to be posted shortly. The year's first day sail will be Saturday, January 12th, with a potential boat christening during that event.

Social Director: Lynette Beal discussed:

- Monthly birthday celebrations at Flip Flops. These will be the 2nd Thursday of each month, starting with January, which will be on Jan. 10th.
- COC Saturday, Jan 26th, from 6:00 PM to 11:00 PM at the Lighthouse Pointe Yacht and Racquet Club. Please send in your checks by January 16th.
- Super Bowl Party Free event. February 3rd at Savor Cinema at 4:00 PM. See flyer for more details.
- Party in Red February 23rd from 7:00-11:00 PM. There will be a "Best Italian Dish" contest and a "Best Dance" contest. See flier for details.

Fleet Captain: Debi Hallmark - Reported that there has already been one overnight sail this year during New Year's Eve. Three boats went out: Captain John, Captain James & Captain Debi with 11 total crew. Debi is planning to meet with the Captains' to set up more overnight sails throughout the year. Currently already on the agenda: 1) Circle Raft-Up, Saturday, March 1st (jointly with HISC), and 2) Extended Cruise to the Keys in April (10 days or greater). She plans on changing crew throughout the event so more members can participate.
